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CODY'S STORY



On February 9, 1991, Cody Jude Barrasse entered this world at 11:49 PM with a bang. That was the start of an incredible journey. On April 7, 2013, at 4:46 AM, he quietly left this world, much sooner than ever expected, but left a mark that runs deep. Cody was 22 years old when he died of a head injury sustained after he was struck by a car as a pedestrian. Cody had a unique and special spirit. He was never afraid to go against the norm or question why something was done a certain way. His fundamental belief was equality. Cody was a hero until his last breath. He gave the ultimate gift — “The Gift of Life”.

Cody's Organ Donations included :

- An 18 month old received the small piece of his liver.
- A middle aged woman, the larger piece.
- A 9 year old boy his loving heart.
- A 12 year old boy his pancreas and 1 kidney.
- A middle aged woman received his second kidney.
- A 64 year old roofer now breathes through Cody's strong lungs.
- One cornea and a substantial amount of skin was also donated

WHAT WE'RE OFFERING

After Cody's tragic passing, a number of close friends and family established the Cody Barrasse Memorial Foundation. The goal of the Foundation is not only to carry on the legacy Cody left behind, but also to promote organ donor awareness and provide service to those awaiting transplantation. A part of the foundation's mission is to help defray the cost of those awaiting transplantation in Lackawanna County.
